


Bath Shelf with 2 Towel Rods






Part List-Bath Shelf with 2 Towel Rods



Identifying the hardware-Identify the hardware using the illustrations below.

Note: If possible, we recommend that you secure cleat (B) to stud in wall.

Step 2


Position Cleat (B) on wall in desired location where shelf will be hung. Make sure cleat is level.

Step 3

Using Cleat (B) as template, align holes in cleat to studs in wall. Drill 1/8" pilot holes 3/4" deep.

Step 4


Attach French Cleat (B) to Studs in wall in at least 2 locations using wood screws (C)




Step 5

If hole locations do not align with stud in wall, install the EZ Anchor(E) in to drywall by tapping it in to the predrilled pilot holes up to the thread, and then screwing the EZ Anchor in to the drywall. Attach Cleat (B) using wood screw (D) to EZ Anchors.

NOTE: Cleat could be secured using combination of Studs and EZ Anchors.



Step 6: Hang Bath Shelf(A) on cleat. Secure in 2 places using wood screw (C).
